No Limits Payments

A reminder that all payments for No Limits need to be made via Wisepay by 30th June. Any issues please contact our finance department to discuss.

- Year 7 – £30 per student to pay for an external trip and fantastic activities that will be going on in school.
- Year 8 – £5 per day that the students are in school. E.g.: if they are in all two days it is £15, but if they go to the Birks on Friday 12th then they just pay for the two days they are participating in No Limits.
- Year 9 – £30 per student to pay for an external trip and fantastic activities that will be going on in school.

Exceptions – If you have children in Year 7 and Year 9 the cost is £30 for the first child and then £20 for each child after that. E.g.: Siblings in Year 7 and 9 would cost £50.
